


Welcome to Year 2!

An expanded noun phrase tells you more about the noun. E.g.




Determiner + adjective + noun

Maths


In Maths, we are focusing on multiplication and division. We will be using the following methods:

$$3x2 = 6$$

2+2+2=6



$$15 \div 5 = 3$$
