Thank you once again for your co-operation throughout this time. There are a few things to remind you about:

Breakfast

School has been lucky enough to secure some funding with a company called Magic Breakfast. This means that every child in school is offered breakfast, in their classroom everyday with no charge for parents/carers. We are encouraging the children to decide whether they want a bagel or cereal on a daily basis and this is part of the children's daily routine.

PE Kits

Please send your child to school in their PE kit on their allocated day. Do not send a uniform into school with them as they will remain in their kits until home time. Please ensure they have sensible footwear on to participate in the PE session, (pumps get wet in the rain – they can bring a change of footwear if the weather is bad). They can also wear a jumper or hoody on PE days to keep them warm.

Lunches

If you do not opt for school meals, please ensure that your child has a healthy packed lunch. If you are stuck for ideas please get in touch with the office who will be happy to send some ideas to you. Please do not send any kind of foods containing nuts as we have children in school with severe nut allergies. If your child has grapes in their lunchbox that they are cut in half (lengthways) to prevent a choking hazard.

Medicines

Please ensure if your child has any medicine in school that it is date. This includes any creams, inhalers or epi pens.

Staying Well & Keeping Safe

If anybody in your household starts to develop symptoms of Covid 19 (temperature, persistent cough, change in sense of smell or taste) please inform school at the earliest opportunity so we can ensure we are able to follow government guidance and keep all our children, families and staff safe. A persistent cough means a cough that remains for a few days. If you are unsure about anything please contact school.

Please do not forget to wear a face mask when you are dropping off and collecting your child/children from school and that social distancing is observed at all times.
