


Welcome to Year 3!

English


In English, we are reading 'The Selfish Giant' by Oscar Wilde. A lovely story that shows the importance of friendship and kindness.


We will be looking at contractions (e.g. was not = wasn't), capital letters, full stops and conjunctions.
