By the end of this term, children should be able to instantly recall the following facts.

$0+10=10$	$3+7=10$	$5+5=10$
$10+0=10$	$7+3=10$	$10=5+5$
$10=10+0$	$10=7+3$	
$10=0+10$	$10=3+7$	
$1+9=10$	$4+6=10$	$8+2=10$
$9+1=10$	$6+4=10$	$2+8=10$
$10=9+1$	$10=6+4$	$10=8+2$
$10=1+9$	$10=4+6$	$10=2+10$

What is 3 add 2?

What is 2 plus 2?

What is 5 take away 2?

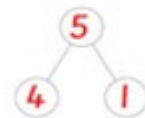
What is 1 less than 4?
