- Identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
- Classify, sort and group living things (example: reptiles)
- Observe and research changes to the environment and study how this affects wildlife. At home, you can help by talking about ways human activity impact on wildlife and their habitats (example: littering)

Our reading focus this term is around book discussion. We want to really immerse ourselves in the story and share all our ideas about the book as a class.

We will look at improving our reading fluency and developing our comprehension skills.

Geography

History

This term in Music Y4 will be learning to play the recorder.

French
